MEMBER VOTE TO AMEND ARTICLES/BYLAWS RESULTS:

Dear BAWBP member:

On November 1, 2019, we mailed <u>415</u> ballots to the mailing address of all members of record <u>as of October 31</u>. <u>277</u> "<u>YES</u>" votes (two-thirds of members) were required to amend our Articles. Bylaws must conform to the Articles; therefore, approval of the Articles amendment was first required in order to pass the amendments to the bylaws.

We received <u>184</u> ballots, less than the 277 required "YES" vote number. Therefore, the vote to amend our Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws did not meet participation requirements to amend, negating the need to count the ballots. Both governing documents will remain as stated prior to this vote.

Membership has steadily grown since 2014 which indicates overwhelming support of the Board's work to improve our beach park amenity. However, for the past three years, attendance at the Annual Member's Meeting has failed to meet the 30% quorum to transact business. Hopefully, members will make a commitment to attend this coming year, where we elect directors to your board, review financials, accomplishments, plans going forward, and this year we will explain our vote counting process.
